The Oakland Ice Center Operated by Sharks Ice is the newest ice skating facility in California to be operated by the San Jose Sharks of the NHL. Located in Downtown Oakland, the facility completed in 1995, contains one NHL-sized ice surface (200-by-85 feet) and one Olympic sized ice surface (200-by-100 feet). The Ice Center accommodates ice hockey, figure skating, broomball, curling, speed skating, ice dancing, as well as public skating.
