Guidelines for Trial Judge or Other Officials Training Support

Because we recognize how essential a strong community of officials is to any club, the Board of Directors of the St. Moritz Ice Skating Club is pleased to make available grant applications for the partial reimbursement of expenses incurred in trial judging or training for test and competition appointments. Following are *maximum* figures per activity that the St. Moritz Ice Skating Club will accept in applications for trial judge or training reimbursement. You are welcome to apply for the maximum amount if your expenses meet or exceed that figure, but bear in mind that depending on the club's current fiscal situation, it may not be in our power to grant the full amount listed here.

In addition there will be an annual cap per person of \$800. Note that the cap per person will not include support for those trial judging/training at a U.S. Championship event, which will be evaluated on a case by case basis and separate from other training or education opportunities.

We welcome applications from trial judges seeking appointments in all disciplines and for those training as officials in other areas (e.g., technical panel, accounting, music, announcing). If you are an official at a competition and also trialing or training, your expenses should be covered by the LOC. In the unlikely event that you are charged some sort of fee even though judging officially, please include a letter to that effect from a member of the competition LOC along with your grant application. Please submit only one application for each competition, even if you will be trialing/training for multiple appointments. You may, however, submit more than one application per fiscal (calendar) year. And, remember to include your receipts or copies of receipts; or, in the case of mileage, precise mileage figures.

Maximum Expense Reimbursement Amounts for Support

Non-Qual, Regional or Sectional competitions held in northern California:	\$125
Non-Qual, Regional or Sectional competitions held in southern California:	\$250
Non-Qual, Regional or Sectional competitions held outside California:	\$400
U.S. Championships (singles/pairs/dance or synchro):	To be determined individually ¹
Schools/Seminars or test sessions outside Northern California:	\$250
Mileage reimbursement for test sessions or schools/seminars, +50 miles in distance	Current IRS rate
